- 1) The **thumb** is the closest finger to you, so start praying for those who are closest to you. They are the persons easiest to remember. To pray for our dear ones is a "sweet obligation".
- 2) The next finger is the **index**. Pray for those who teach you, instruct you, and heal you. They need the support and wisdom to show direction to others. Always keep them in your prayers.
- 3) The following finger is the **tallest**. It reminds us of our leaders, the governors and those who have authority. They need God's guidance.
- 4) The fourth finger is the **ring** finger. It is the weakest finger. It should remind us to prayer for the weakest, the sick or those plagued by problems. They need our prayers.
- 5) Finally we have our **pinkie** finger, the smallest of all. It should remind you to pray for yourself when you are done praying for the four other groups. You will be able to see your own needs but in the proper perspective and also you will be able to pray for your own needs in a better way.
