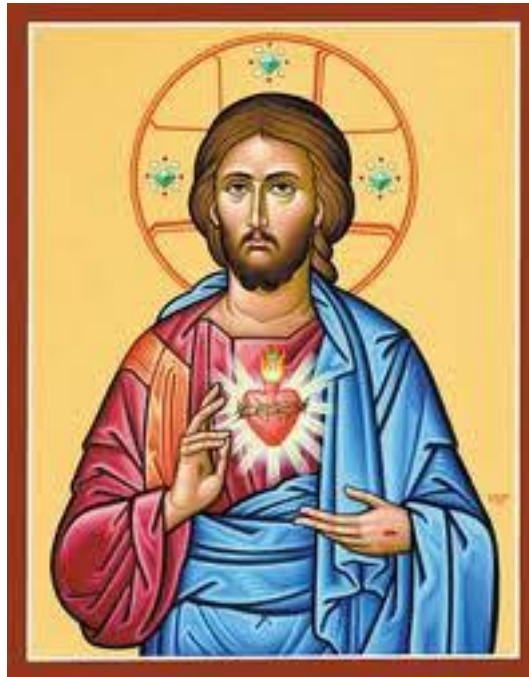
Applications must be returned either by email or mail by May 31, 2020.

Pentecost Cemetery Services – will be held at Victoria Lawn Cemetery beginning Sunday May 31st at 1 p.m. Fr. Anton will start at the Mausoleum and proceed from there, from graves closest to farthest. We ask that you stay at your loved one's grave site and Fr. Anton will look for you. Please have no more than 4 people in attendance, per grave site. During this time we ask that everyone be respectful of one another and social distance.
