The Ukrainian Canadian Congress Niagara Branch is launching the National **Holodomor** Awareness Week November 19-25, 2018 to commemorate the 85th anniversary of the **Holodomor** – Famine Genocide of 1932-33. We encourage everyone to participate in at least one event this week.

*****Tuesday Nov. 20th** – “*Hunger For Truth: The Rhea Clyman Story*” documentary. Introduction and discussion with Prof. Bohdan Nebesio, Brock University. St. Catharines Public Library at 7 p.m. Free admission, donations of canned goods for community care accepted.

*****Friday Nov. 23rd** - “*Hunger For Truth: The Rhea Clyman Story*” documentary will be shown at St. Georges Orthodox Church at 2 p.m.

*****Saturday Nov. 24th** – all are asked to light a candle at 7:30 p.m. and pause to pray for the victims of the Holodomor Famine Genocide.

*****Sunday Nov. 25th** - **Holodomor Commemoration** at Sts. Cyril & Methodius Church at 2:30 p.m. There will be a program and candle lighting ceremony. Admission is canned or dried goods for Community Care or donations towards the Holodomor Education Fund.

*****Holodomor A Genocide – 85th Anniversary Commemorative Exhibit.** St. Catharines Museum Lock 3: 1932 Welland Canal Parkway, St. Catharines. *Exhibit is on until November 30th.* Museum is open daily 9 a.m – 5 p.m. (please call ahead to confirm viewing times (905) 984-8880).

As always, St. Johns will display 33 black flags, on our lawn to represent those who died during Holodomor Awareness Week along with a Panachyda following Divine Liturgy on Sunday November 25th to honor the millions of people who perished.
