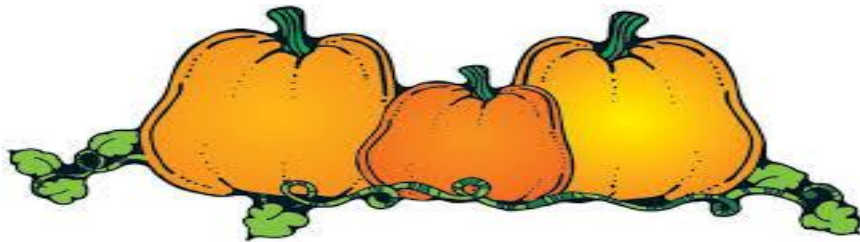


## October Family Pasta Night
